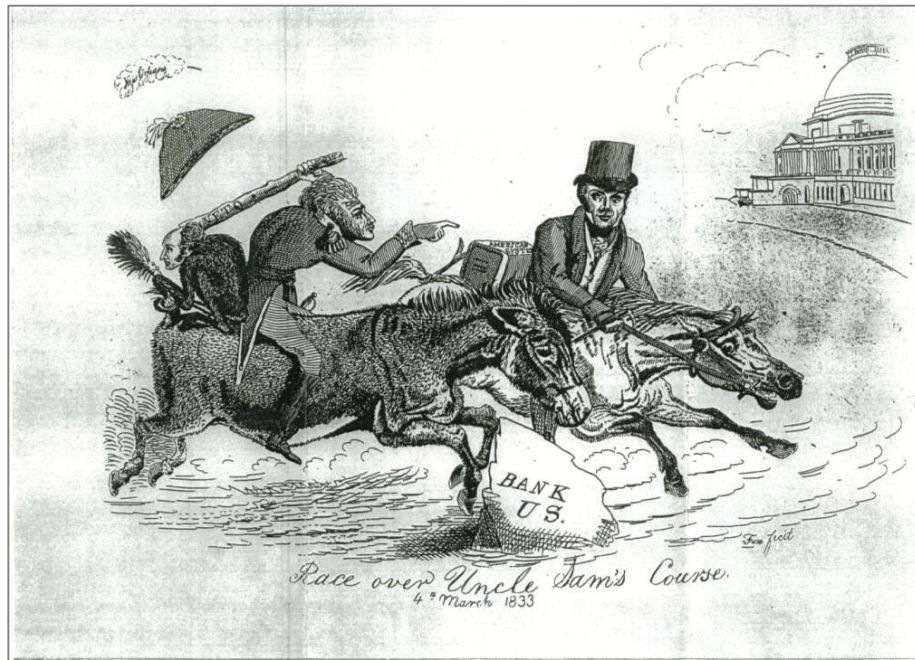


Political Cartoon Project: Democracy in the Age of Jackson
