






Uniform Rules

Uniforms are required for grades K-8. Early dismissal days are NON-UNIFORM days. Please refer to requirements below or visit the school website for more information.



Girls K-5

-  Plaid jumper or navy blue skirt
-  White long- or short-sleeve blouse or golf shirt (any collar)




Girls Grades 6-8


-  Plaid skirt
-  White long- or short-sleeve blouse or golf shirt
-  All girls may wear navy blue shorts in September/October and May/June. Navy blue pants can be worn November through April.

Boys K-4








-  Navy blue pants with a belt
-  White long- or short-sleeve golf shirt

Boys Grades 5-8

-  Navy blue pants with a belt
-  White long- or short-sleeve dress shirt and tie
-  All boys may wear navy blue shorts in September/October and May/June

-  **Socks and Tights:** Only solid-colored white, black, red, or blue socks and tights may be worn

General Requirements:

-  Students can wear any sweatshirt with the Nativity logo to school.
-  Uniform attire will be in effect from the first day of school in September until the last day of school in June.
-  Clogs or clog-like shoes, platform shoes, combat-style boots, roller sneakers, and flip-flops are not allowed.
-  Cargo pants and shorts are not allowed.
-  No printed t-shirts should be visible through the white uniform shirt.
-  If a child is not dressed in uniform, a written excuse from the parents must be given to the homeroom teacher upon arrival.
-  All shirts and blouses are to be tucked in. Failure to comply may result in the student being issued a detention.
