



2018-2019 SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Uniforms are required for grades K-8

General Rules:

- All girls- Jumpers, skirts, skorts- uniform plaid only
- All students- During the months of September and October, May and June – may wear navy blue dress shorts rather than pants with a polo shirt.
- Any student wearing a polo shirt has the option of wearing a white polo shirt with or without the embroidered Nativity logo for the 2018-2019 school year
- All students-Socks or tights must be worn and must be solid colored- white, black, red or blue
- All students-Casual or dress shoes or sneakers are permitted to be worn
- **Uniform attire will be in effect from the first day of school in September until the last day of school in June.**
- Cargo pants or cargo shorts are NOT allowed as part of the school uniform in any grade.
- No printed t-shirts should be visible through the white dress shirt.
- If a child is not dressed in uniform, a written excuse from the parents must be given to the homeroom teacher upon arrival.
- All shirts and blouses are to be tucked into the skirts, pants, or shorts. Failure to comply may result in the student being issued a detention.
- Parent cooperation with the uniform policy is greatly appreciated.

Girls Grades K-5 -

~plaid jumper or plaid skort

~white long sleeve or short sleeve blouse (any appropriate collar) or polo shirt

~optional – any sweater or sweatshirt with the Nativity logo

Girls Grades 6-8 –

~plaid skirt

~white long or short sleeve dress blouse or polo shirt

~optional – red or black Nativity sweat shirt or jacket with Nativity logo

Girls Grades K-8- Winter Uniforms- November to April-

~Are permitted to wear navy blue pants rather than school jumper, skirt or skort

Boys Grades K-4 –

~navy blue pants with a belt

~white long sleeve or short sleeve dress shirt or polo shirt (tie is not required)

~ Boys Grades 5-8 –

~navy blue pants with belt

~white long sleeve or short sleeve dress shirt

~school tie is required
