### COMPUTER Supply List:

- **Grades Pre-K – 5:** 1 container of Clorox wipes.
- **Grades 2 – 8:** 1 pair of Headphones or Earbuds.  
They should bring them to the Computer Lab when they have a class
- **Grades 6 – 8:** Should have a padded carry case to keep their school issued Chromebook in for easy travel between classes and for taking it home

## **Library Supply List:**

Dear Parents,

This year, in order to keep us all safe and healthy, I am asking every student to purchase tissues, hand sanitizer, or anti-bacterial wipes (depending on grade level). I realize this is a tough-ask because many of the items are not available or are in limited supply in stores. Please bring in whatever you can to help me keep the library germ-free and safe for our children. You'll be happy to know I'm a known germaphobe, so, if I have the supplies, I will sanitize your children's hands and anything they touch frequently throughout the day!

We are approaching 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade library differently this year. For the first part of the year, I will be teaching the junior high students Executive Function skills. Executive Function (EF) is the mental processes that help us plan, organize, strategize, pay attention to details, and manage time. Executive Function "happens" in the pre-frontal cortex, which is not well developed in the adolescent brain. We are going to work on developing these skills in library this year.

**During the first week of school I will send home information for signing up to our virtual library classrooms.** I will send updated codes and instructions for how to join **our library google classrooms** for the 2020-2021 school year. I will post announcements and keep parents current with our weekly lessons. This will serve as an introduction to parents and students, who are new to google classroom, and a tutorial on how to navigate the virtual format. This way, if we must learn virtually again, we are all ready to go!

## Kindergarten Supply List

- **Face masks are required- surgical or cloth**
- please remember to label your child's items as we will not be sharing any materials this year.
- 3 containers of disinfectant wipes
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 plastic bin with a lid to keep all of your child's belongings in (including a change of clothes and art smock). This bin will be either next to them or under them for convenience.
- 1 change of clothes (not a uniform)
- 1 art smock ( a mens old t-shirt works best)
- 1 beach towel for play time. They will be placed 6 feet apart.
- 1 small bag of books and toys (they will have individual play time each day when we can't play outside). The toys will not and cannot be shared with friends. They will go home each day to be washed. I think a book or two and a few small figurines will do the job great. Blocks or legos are great too.
- 2 kindergarten/ela journals. They are generally blue. The top of the page is a square for a picture and the bottom has dotted lines for writing.
- 2 packs of crayons
- 2 packs of markers
- 8-10 glue sticks
- Scissors
- White board (dollar tree)
- White board markers
- 24 pack of number 2 pencils, pre-sharpened
- The children will need 100 of something. These will be used for math when they are learning to count. Some cheap ideas include- erasers(target dollar spot), buttons, dollar store legos, flat
- beads, pennies,
- 1 box of ziploc bags(any size)

\*Please **NO mechanical or bendable pencils**.
- a small pencil sharpener for your child to keep at the desk for easy access
- 2 Pink Pearl Erasers
- 5 highlighters (1 of each color: yellow, pink, green, blue, and orange)  
\*The BIC brand comes in a package with all of these colors.
- 2 boxes of Crayola Crayons **24 count** only please
- 2 boxes of Crayola Markers **10 Classic Colors (thick/broad tip)**
- 6 large Elmer's glue sticks or 12 small Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 pairs of Fiskars scissors \*Please label with child's name.
- 6 containers of Clorox wipes
- 3 boxes of tissues
- P.E. clothes in a bag (a drawstring sack works great!). \*Please label clothes with your child's name.
- Art Smock -an old shirt makes a great art smock! \*Please label with your child's name.

*I will be purchasing some supplies for the second grade students. These supplies include take home folders, red pens, dry erase boards/markers, colored pencils, pencil pouches, and plastic bins for their supplies. I do not know the cost of these supplies yet, so I will let you know at the beginning of the school year. These supplies will be used by your child throughout the school year in the classroom. These materials will come home with your child at the end of the school year.*

**\*\*PLEASE LABEL all supplies with your child's name or initials.**

**Also, it is very helpful that uniforms, P.E. clothes, and art smocks are also labeled.**

**\*\*PLEASE DO NOT SEND IN ANY ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES, such as pencil boxes or pouches as I will have both of these for your child.**  
**Any additional supplies will be sent home.\*\***

### Third Grade Supply List

- **Face masks are required- surgical or cloth**

\*Each child's supplies will be kept in a clear Rubbermaid or similar brand container with a lid. The container should be of the 56 or 70 Quart Size. Please label all items with your name in permanent marker.

\*The following items in the first list will be kept in the container with other personal items. Please don't bring in pencil boxes. In third grade, we keep coloring supplies, etc., in the ziplock bags.

- 1 pack of mechanical pencils and
- 1 pack of regular pencils with an individual sharpener is provided
- A pack of ten red pens
