

Dear First and Second grade families:

We have received a lot of interest about our younger students participating in Festival Chorus. However, due to the difficulty of the music and the maturity level of our young students, I haven't allowed students below third grade to participate. This spring, we are going to be forming a Cherub Choir for our first and second grade students, so that they may "try out" group singing to see if it is something that they would like to pursue in third grade. First and second grade students will be learning three age-appropriate songs in their music classes this spring and will rehearse as a group a few times beginning in March. Then, **they will perform on May 24th** with our Festival Chorus, Women's Choir, Concert Band and String Orchestra at our Spring Concert. Performing at this concert also allows our second graders to see our band, orchestra, and advanced choirs in action so that they can see if they'd like to pursue an instrument in third grade. We are hoping to hold our concert outdoors (rain location: Gym) in order to mitigate COVID concerns. We had a very successful Christmas Concert and are hoping to continue that success this spring.
