COMPUTER:

Grades Pre-K – 5: NO wipes this year.

Grades 6 – 8: 1 box of Kleenex.

Fourth Grade:
Two-pocket folder with clips (any color)

Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth Grades:
Two-pocket folder with clips (any color)
Pair of earbuds or headphones (can be the same ones used for Technology)

Band, Orchestra, and all Choruses:
Folders are provided at first rehearsal
Band/Orchestra students will be contacted about lesson books
Make sure you have a personal supply of reeds, strings, etc.

Religion:

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grade

Kindergarten:

*Please label all things with your child's first and last name. You do not need to label each crayon or marker just the boxes

- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes

- 1 change of clothes (not a uniform)
- 1 art smock (oversized t-shirt works best)
- 2 kindergarten journals (they are usually blue. A square at the top of the page with lines underneath) 1- Math, 1-ELA
- 2 Packs of crayons
- 2 packs of markers
- 10 glue sticks
- Scissors (child)
- White board and dry erase markers
- 24 number 2 pencils, sharpened
- 1 box of Ziploc bags (you choose what size)
- \$5 to cover the cost of their red take home folder and the plastic box that they will keep all of their supplies in (I will purchase them so they are all the same and fit nicely on the book shelf)



First Grade:

Please label all school supplies

- 4, two pocket folders (1 for the classroom, 1 for Religion, 1 for Music, and 1 for Library. Mrs. Esack, Mrs. Williams, and Dr. Gradwell have these listed on their supply lists.) Please label these folders with your child's name **ONLY**.
- 24 **sharpened** #2 pencils to start the year; more pencils will be needed as the year goes on *Please **NO** mechanical or bendable pencils.
- a small pencil sharpener for your child to keep at the desk for easy access
- 1 Pink Pearl Erasers
- 5 highlighters (1 of each color: yellow, pink, green, blue, and orange)
*The BIC brand comes in a package with all of these colors.
- 2 boxes of Crayola Crayons **24 count** only please
The second box is for later in the school year.
- 2 boxes of Crayola Markers **10 Classic Colors (thick/broad tip)**
The second box is for later in the school year.
- 6 large Elmer's glue sticks or 12 small Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 pairs of Fiskars scissors *Please label with child's name.
- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes
- 3 boxes of tissues
- Art Smock -an old shirt makes a great art smock! **Please label with your child's name.*
- Headphone or earbuds for Computer class. (This is on Mr. Hutter's supply list.)

Please note:

In addition to being used in the second grade classroom, the crayons, markers, and scissors listed above will also be used for Religion, Art, and Music. Additional crayons, markers, and scissors DO NOT need to be purchased for Religion, Art, and Music.

Students will need all supplies on the Library supply list Library except for the pouch

I will be purchasing some supplies for the second grade students.

*These supplies include pencil **pouches for BOTH the classroom and Library**, take home folders, red pens, dry erase boards/markers, colored pencils, and plastic totes for their supplies. The small plastic totes will be used to store crayons, markers, and scissors. These small totes will travel to Religion, Art, and Music with the students.*

At this time I do not know the cost of these supplies, so I will let you know the cost at the beginning of the school year. These supplies will be used by your child throughout the school year in the classroom. These materials will come home with your child at the end of the school year.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND IN ANY ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES, such as pencil boxes or pouches as I will have both of these for your child.

Any additional supplies will be sent home.

****PLEASE LABEL all supplies with your child's name or initials.
Also, it is very helpful that school uniform sweatshirts are labeled.**
