# CHORUS <br> ORCHESTRA <br> Grades 3-8 

## Dear Nativity Families:

As you look forward to the 2024-2025 school year, you may consider adding the study of a musical instrument or chorus to your student's school routine. Learning an instrument helps your child to develop important life skills and provides students with a safe opportunity to express themselves. Students in grades 3-8 will be able to study an instrument or sing in chorus and participate in an ensemble. Students will receive one 30-minute lesson each week (on a rotating basis during the school day) and a one-hour ensemble class after school starting in November/February. These students will perform on the Christmas Concert and on the Spring Concert. Students who sign up for lessons are required to maintain a passing academic average and will be removed from study if they are unable to maintain academic work. Students will also be expected to practice daily. All students will receive a progress rubric at the end of each marking period in lieu of a grade. Make-up lesson times will be available each trimester. If you are continuing study from last year (or are transferring in from another school program) please indicate the instrument that your child studies when you sign up. Students interested in band will have the opportunity to sign up in September through the Paul Effman service.

Your child also has the opportunity to sing in Festival Chorus during the school year. Chorus is open to all students, grades 3-8, and we perform at the Christmas concert, Spring Concert, and various school Mass celebrations. Other special events may include Christmas Caroling and competitions depending on interest). We perform a wide variety of music from all genres, making sure to include repertoire that is diverse and spiritually meaningful. Students are allowed to participate in more than one ensemble. 6th-8th grade girls also have the opportunity to sing in Women's Choir, which meets one morning a week. We may add a men's group if there is interest.

We use Google Classroom and your child will receive login information at their first lesson/rehearsal in September. We also use the Remind text service.

Grades 3-8 Orchestra: Lessons-once a week during the school day; group
rehearsals-Thursday after school 2:30-3:30pm (November-December/February-May)
Grades 3-8 Chorus: Tuesday afternoons, 2:30-3:30pm
Grade 6-8 Women's Choir: Wednesday mornings 7:45-8:15am
WE MAY RUN A MEN'S CHOIR ON THURSDAY MORNINGS IF THERE IS INTEREST
We will begin lessons the week of MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 16th, after school rehearsals for band/morning rehearsals for orchestra will begin on the week of MONDAY, November 4th.
Band and orchestra will have no after school/before school rehearsals mid-December through February break while we prepare for our 2025 musical!

Choruses will begin rehearsals the week of SEPTEMBER 16th.
Chorus also takes December through February off for the musical.
Your child will receive a detailed rehearsal schedule at their first rehearsal.
Please note that Chorus *may* participate in field trips this year, depending on the academic schedule.

## Fees:

All instrumentalists: $\$ 50$ per month, billed through FACTS (you will be charged October-May)
There is no fee for Festival Chorus or Women's Choir.

## RENTAL INFORMATION AND SUPPLIES

Instrumental music students will require:

- Instrument
- String players: rosin, (a set of extra strings is recommended), Cellists should get a "stopper" or strap for the floor.
- A music stand for home practice (not required, but recommend)

Folder and ensemble music will be provided at the first lesson and are included with tuition.
