### **ART:**

#### All Grades

#### Please note:

\*\*PLEASE LABEL all supplies with your child's name or initials. Also, it is very helpful that school uniform sweatshirts are labeled.

# **ELA** (purple)

- 1 purple binder
- 1 purple two pocket folder
- 3 dividers
- Index cards
- 1 subject notebook
- Looseleaf paper (needed daily)
- Need a pen and pencil daily (may not write in colored pen)
- A colored pen (for correcting)
- Suggested (but not required): mini stapler

# Math (blue)

- 2 composition notebooks, <u>preferably graph paper</u> for lining up digits, creating graphs, etc. Students need one notebook to start the year. The second will be used about halfway through and can be purchased at that time rather than now.
- 2 2 pocket folders, blue, paper or plastic <u>WITH PRONGS</u>. Chapter sheets will be added to this folder in lieu of a binder. NO BINDERS.
- 1 or 2 <u>packages of lined paper</u> for scrap work. This paper will be collected and shared with all students throughout the year.
- A colored flair pen for correcting, not red
- <u>Protractor</u> (plastic is fine)
- Calculator: (6, 7, 8r) TI 30X IIS or similar.
- Calculator Algebra Students: Any <u>TI 84</u> Edition
- several pencils, <u>preferably mechanical</u> or whichever the student prefers. If the student prefers <u>wooden pencils</u>, please provide them with a <u>small handheld</u> non-electric pencil sharpener
- 200 or more <u>white index cards</u> for vocabulary to start the year. These will be collected and shared with the students throughout the year.
- \$3 to go toward vocabulary file folders

<sup>\*</sup>Please note, colored pens, paper and index cards are required in the junior high list. As long as students have these items daily, you don't need extras for ELA.



## **SCIENCE** (green)

- 1 2" loose-leaf binder
- metric ruler
- calculator
- 12 binder dividers with label tabs
- 1 green two pocket folder
- 1 package loose-leaf paper
- (grade 6 and 8) roll of paper towels
- (grade 7 only) 1 box of tissues

# **SOCIAL STUDIES** (black)

- Black 2 inch three-ring binder labeled with name and Social Studies
- 8 binder dividers with labels to write on (or the kind that you can write directly on) with pockets
- Black durable plastic folder labeled with Name and "Social Studies Working Folder"
- Lined loose leaf paper
- Pen and pencil for every class (Please, no flair markers for taking notes)
- Suggested for home (to stay at home): plastic or cardboard shoe box designated for Social Studies, index cards, sandwich size ziplock bags (to create, organize, and store flashcards)
- 6th grade only: hand sanitizer
- 7th grade only: kleenex;
- 8th grade only: disinfecting wipes
